And as much as people say imitation is the highest form of flattery, it's not. It's just not cool. And I want to let you guys know that if you've ever been copied and that cut you at your heart and you said to yourself, I don't even want to pursue it. I want to leave that mommy group. I don't want to be part of the PTA. I don't want to launch my product. I don't even want to try this thing because it just hurts so much that somebody would just steals from me. Well remember this. Anybody who copies from you is one step behind you. You're the innovator, you're the motivator, you're the one leading the pack and as long as they're copying, they're always going to show up late. And speaking of showing up late, I want to tell you a story.

So I started out on this little platform called Periscope. It was a live streaming platform that's associated with Twitter and I went on there all the time. And I would lead these amazing, fun, high energy interactive broadcasts where I would tell people about how they can build their business, generate extra income, and have a solid, stable side hustle. The world is waiting for your revolution. So don't apologize or ask permission. Just be you.
